- Do a Google Image search for [___]
- Find a free online game for vocabulary or anatomy
- Write a limerick or haiku using assigned terminology in correct context
- Provide an illustration without labels and have students label relevant pieces
- Watch a suggested TED talk and list points of agreement/disagreement
- Prepare some questions and do an interview with someone who has relevant expertise on [___]
- Do relevant textbook supported activities– games, videos, practice quizzes, etc.
- List key questions (and rationales) to determine the safety of massage for a client with a complex medical history
- Create dyads and have students share their elevator pitches (or equivalents) with each other via Skype or Zoom for feedback.
- PubMed.gov treasure hunt
- Use online trade journal articles for a deeper dive on specific topics (A&P, kinesiology, pathology, business, ethics, etc.)

- Do a search for some specifically *bad* information, and explain why it is not trustworthy
